



California Propane Vehicle Incentive Program Rules and Regulations

WHO AND WHAT IS ELIGIBLE? Incentives are available to California propane customers who purchase a new propane vehicle. Propane companies and their employees are not eligible to receive incentives.

WHAT VEHICLES ARE ELIGIBLE? Any vehicle that is approved by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the California Air Resources Board and is registered and operated in the state of California is eligible for \$1,000 for vehicles and a \$3000 incentive payment for buses. A maximum of two incentives will be paid per applicant per program year.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO IN EXCHANGE FOR THE INCENTIVE FUNDS? The incentive recipient agrees to complete the application form, documenting their reason for selecting a propane vehicle.

WHEN DOES THE PROGRAM BEGIN AND END? The incentive program begins January 1, 2019, and ends December 31, 2019, or when program funds are exhausted. The payment of an incentive under the program or this agreement is subject to available funds. If available funds run out during the program year, WPERC may elect to carry over applications until the next program year. All eligible purchases must occur during the incentive program year.

Completed and approved applications should have an incentive check issued within 60-90 days after the application is received at the WPERC office, subject to available funds. No applicant has a legal right or other entitlement to receive incentive under the program or this agreement. A completed application does not bind WPERC to approve or pay an incentive to any applicant.

An applicant or propane marketer may be suspended from, or declared ineligible to participate in the incentive program if the WPERC determines that the applicant or propane marketer has submitted false information or otherwise violated program terms and conditions. Within 30 days after WPERC suspends or declares an applicant or propane marketer ineligible, the applicant or propane marketer may appeal the action by submitting the appeal in writing to WPERC. Actions taken by WPERC with respect to the appeal will be final. An applicant or propane marketer who submits false information pertinent to an incentive is subject to criminal and civil penalties including U.S. Mail fraud.

Incentive applicants and vehicle dealers agree that the selection, purchase, and ownership of an eligible propane vehicle is solely their responsibility and not the responsibility of WPERC or the Propane Education & Research Council (PERC). WPERC and PERC agents will not recommend equipment, dealers or installers, nor do they make any representation as to the safety, reliability, and/or efficiency of the vehicle or retrofits selected. WPERC and PERC agents do not make any warranty whether expressed or implied, including warranty or merchantability or fitness for any particular purpose, use, or application of the products. Applicant agrees that WPERC agents, PERC agents and propane marketers will not be liable if a person suffers any personal or bodily injury, death, or property damage as a result of use of propane vehicles. Applicant agrees that this release of liability is binding on their personal representatives, successors, heirs, assigns, and next of kin.
